Analyze survey results to identify opportunities for improvement and enhance our overall safety preparedness, awareness, and access to critical resources across School of Medicine.

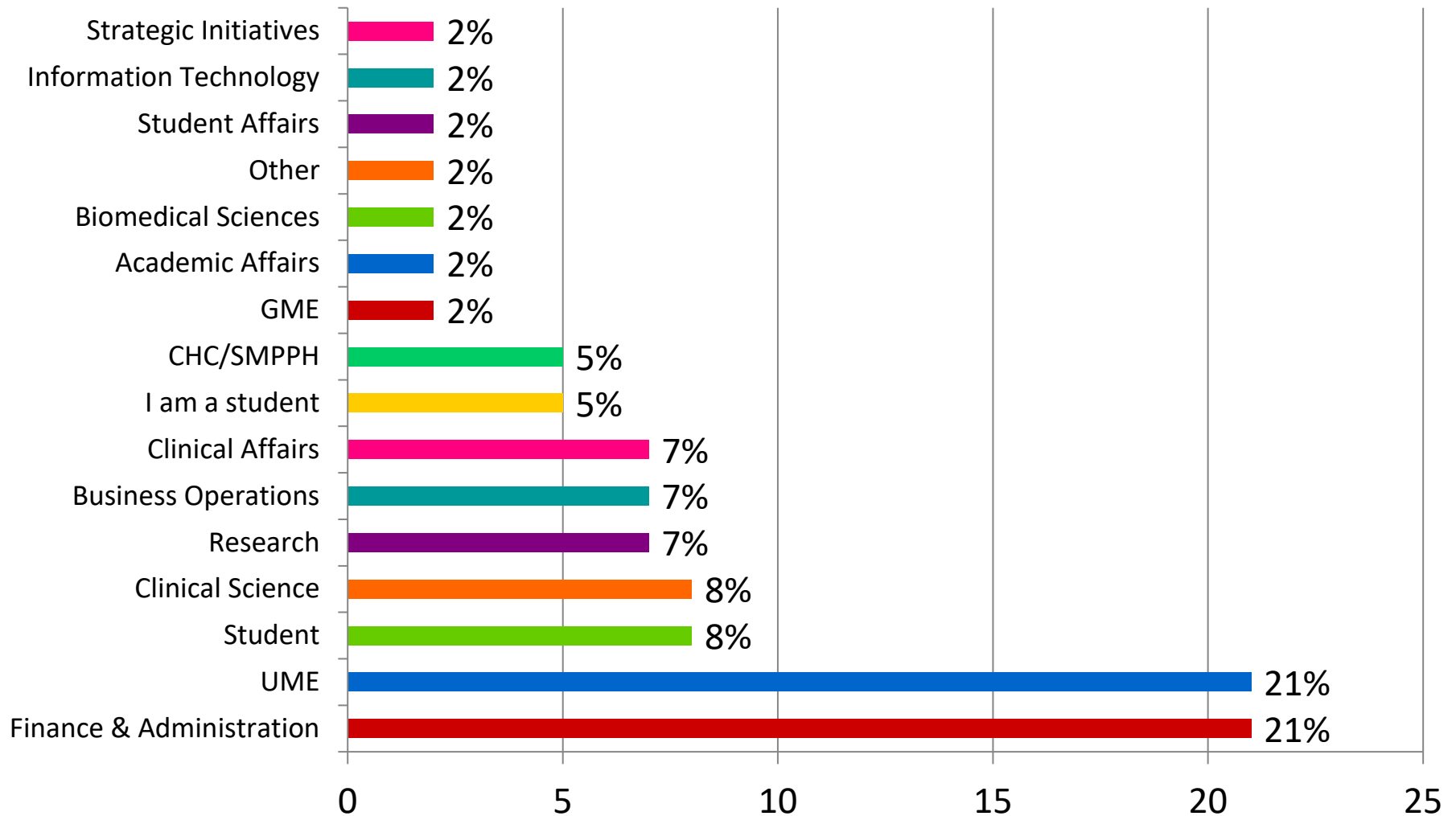
Our Commitment

We are committed to empowering the SOM community with the knowledge and resources needed to confidently navigate safety protocols and respond effectively in emergencies.



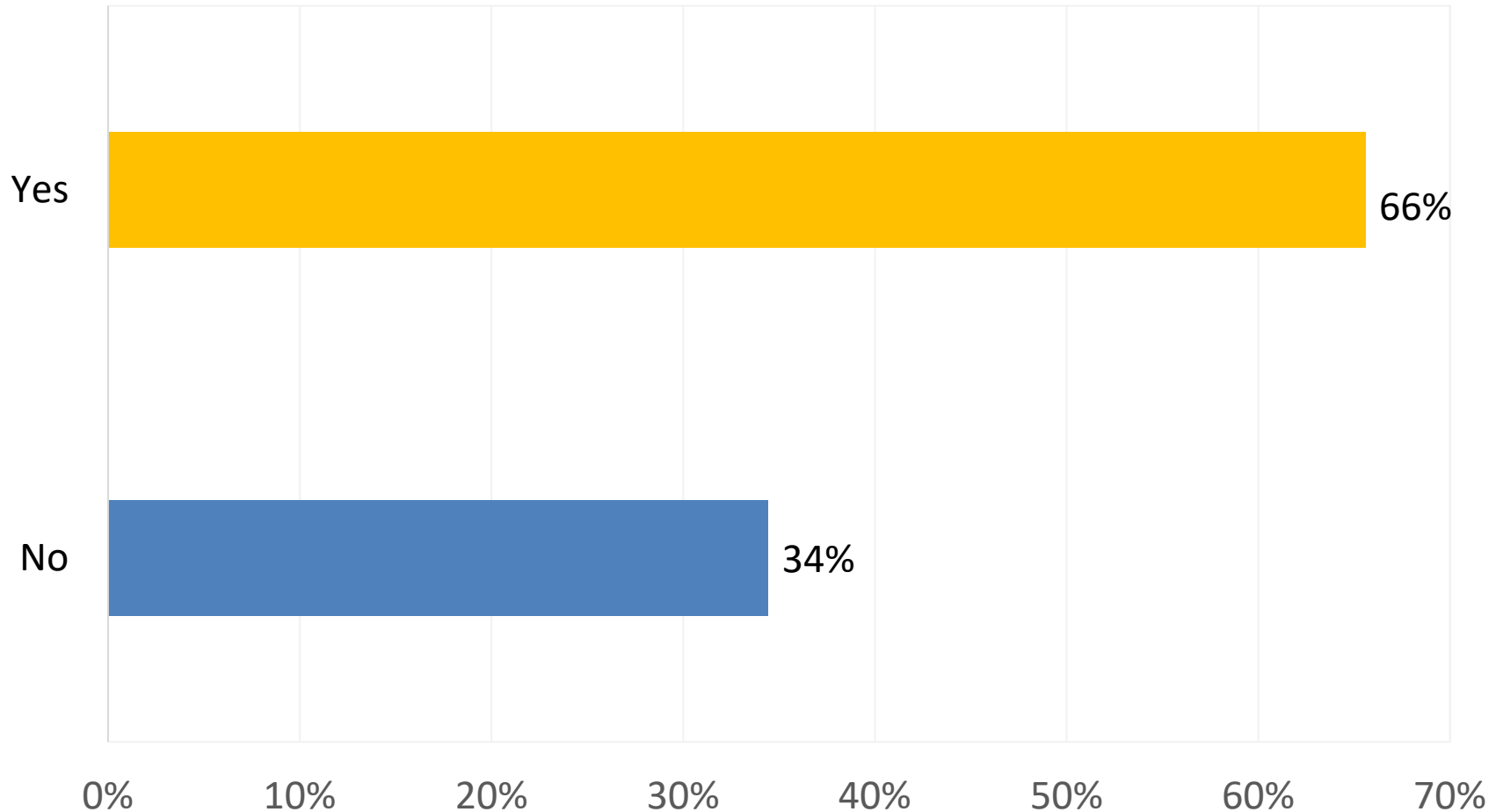

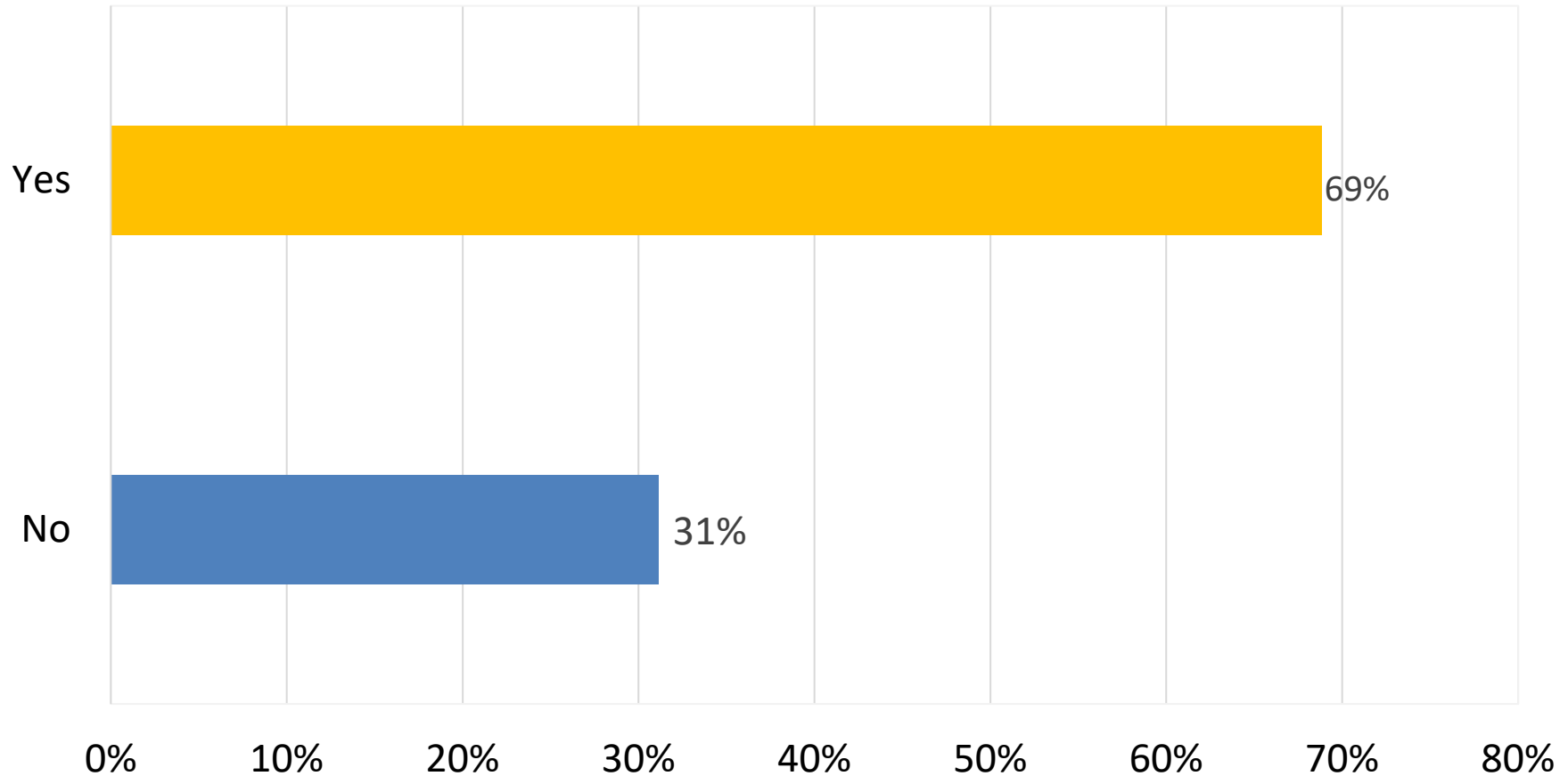

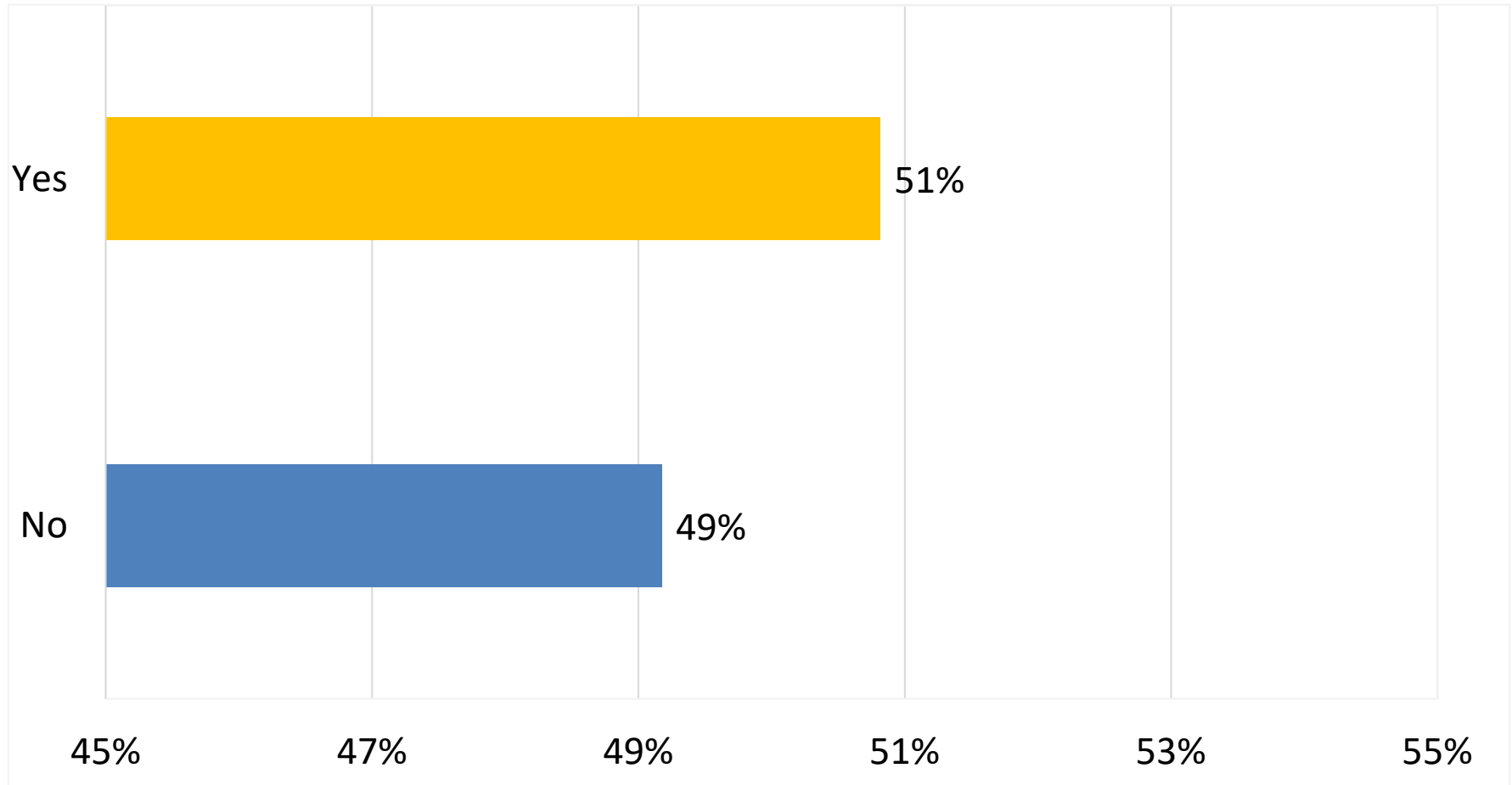
Are you aware that RAVE is our primary emergency notification system used for critical events impacting our SOM buildings?

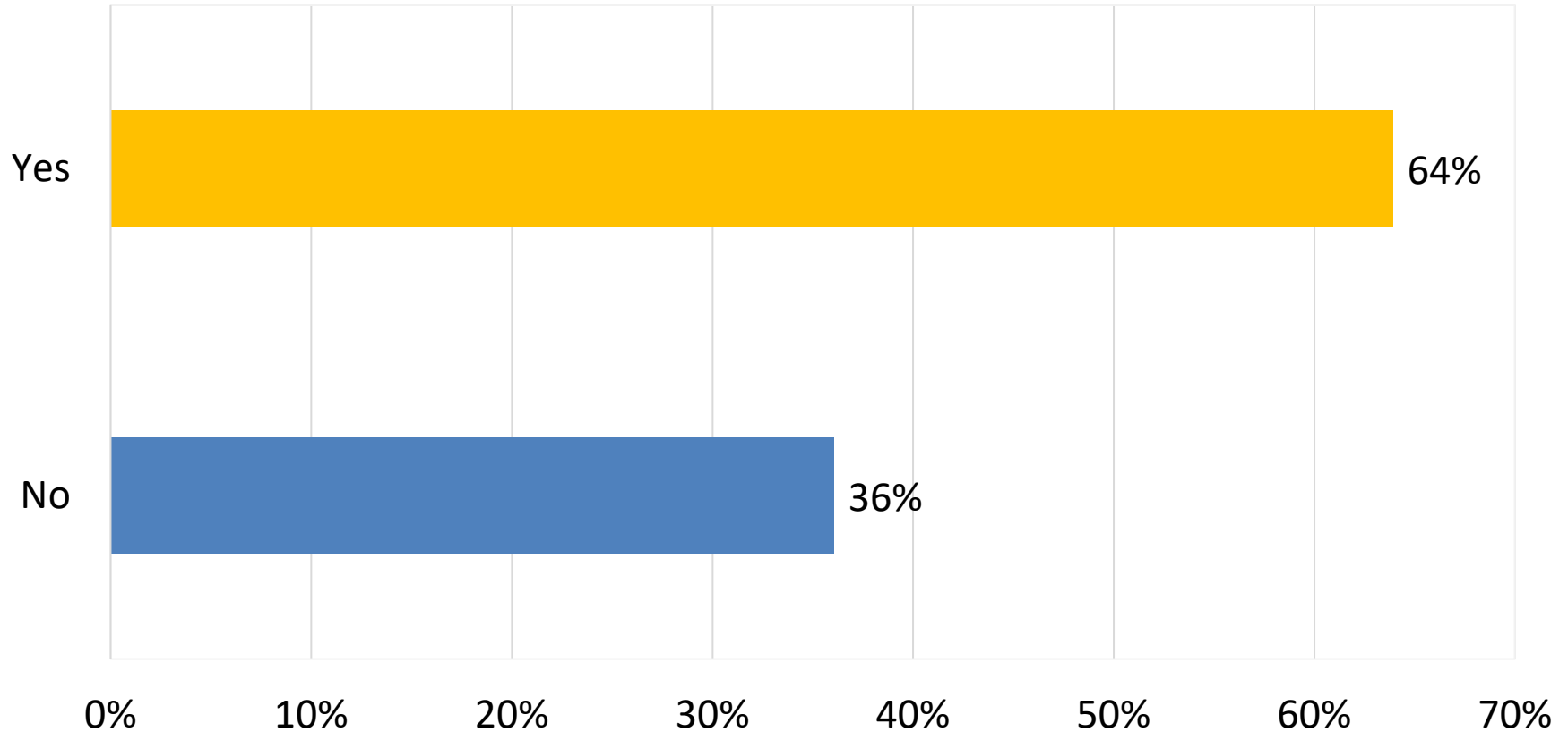

Do you know where the Fire Extinguishers are on your floor?

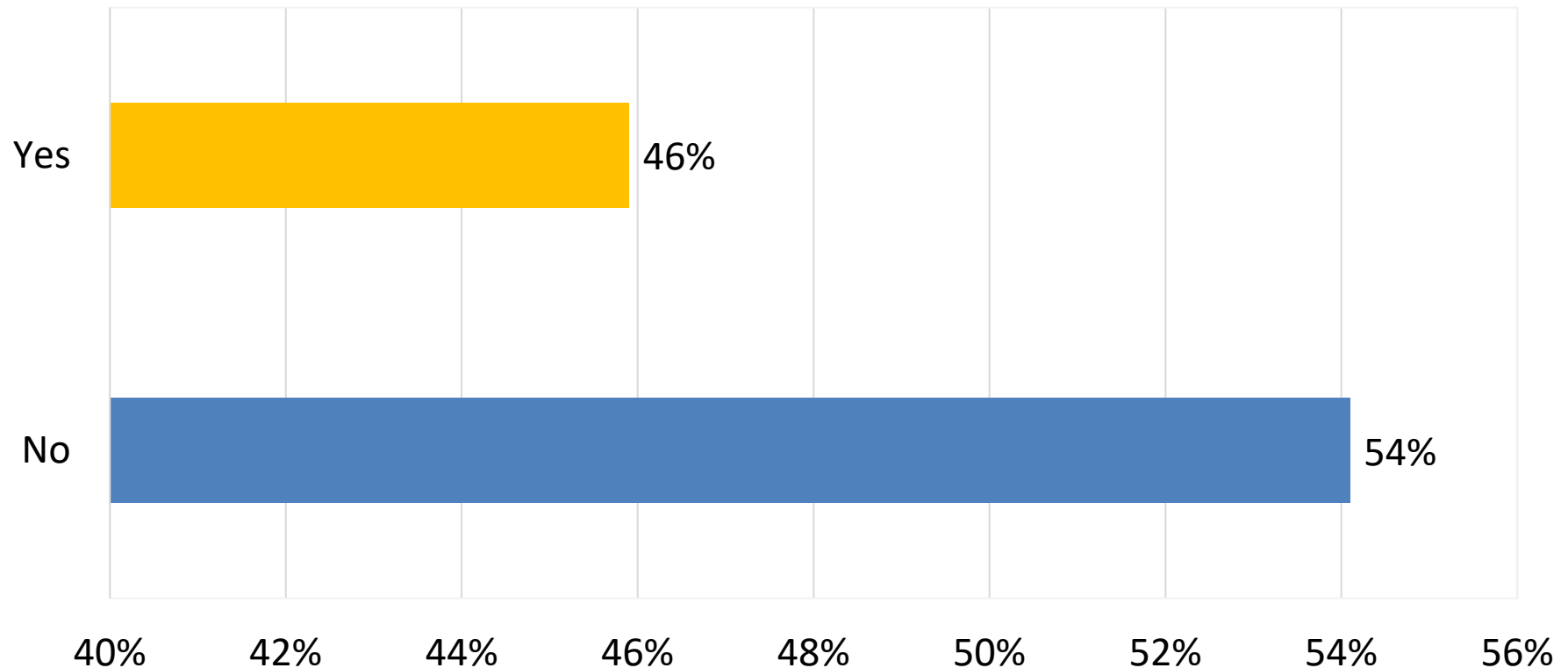
The fire extinguishers are located in various areas of both Ed I and Ed II (by elevators, stairwells, hallways, exits, lounges, and classrooms), please familiarize yourself with their locations on your floor.



Do you know where to locate the Emergency Red Phones (ED I) or Courtesy Call Buttons (ED II) on your floor?

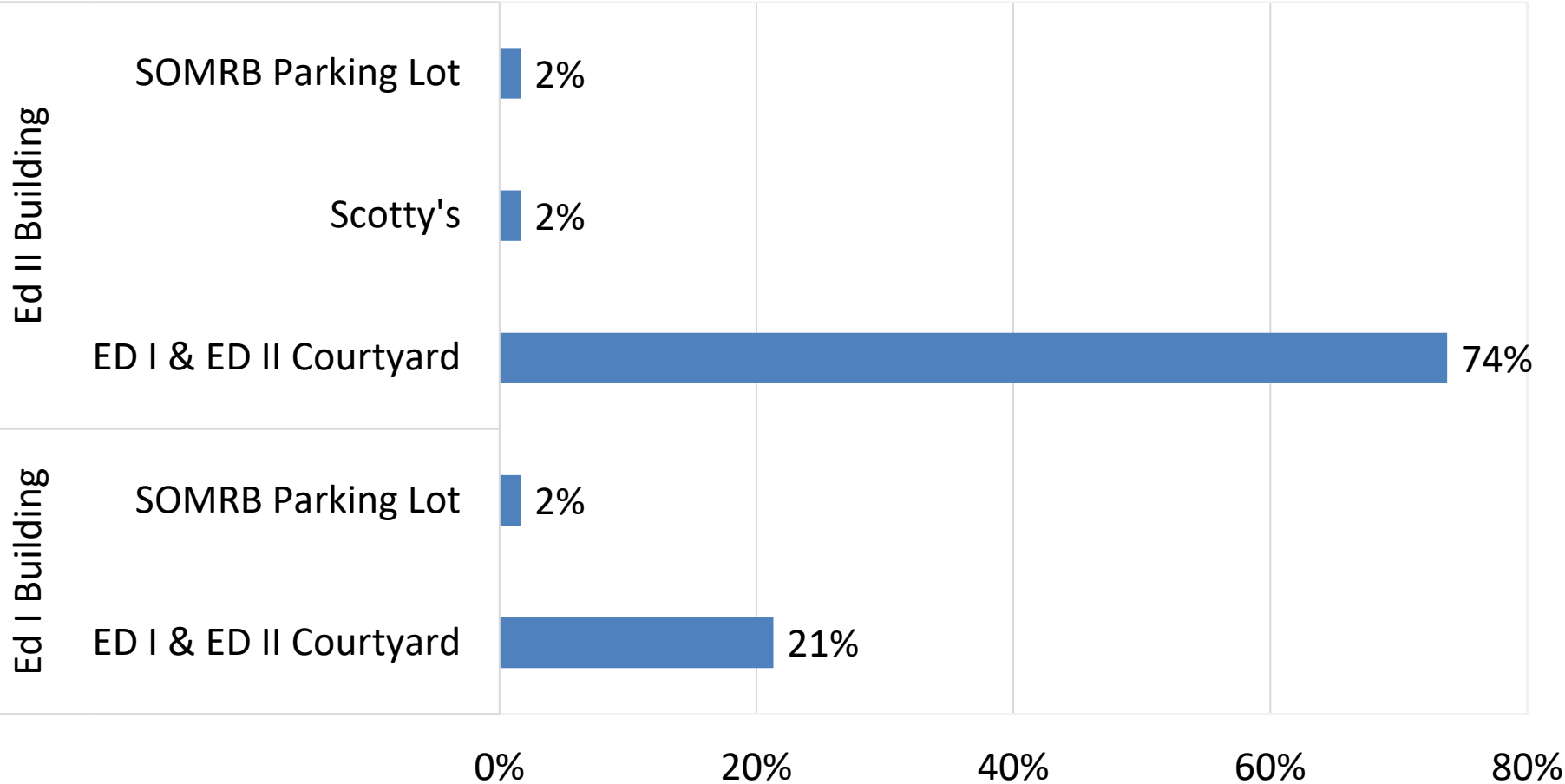
Ed I: The red phones are located at the Reception Desk (1st Floor), next to the AED (Ground Floor), and next to Botanic Conference Room hallway entrance (2nd Floor).

Ed II: The courtesy call buttons are located at the Reception Desk (1st Floor) and by each of the Elevators (3rd, 4th, & 5th floors only).



Where is your building's Emergency Assembly Area (EAA) located?

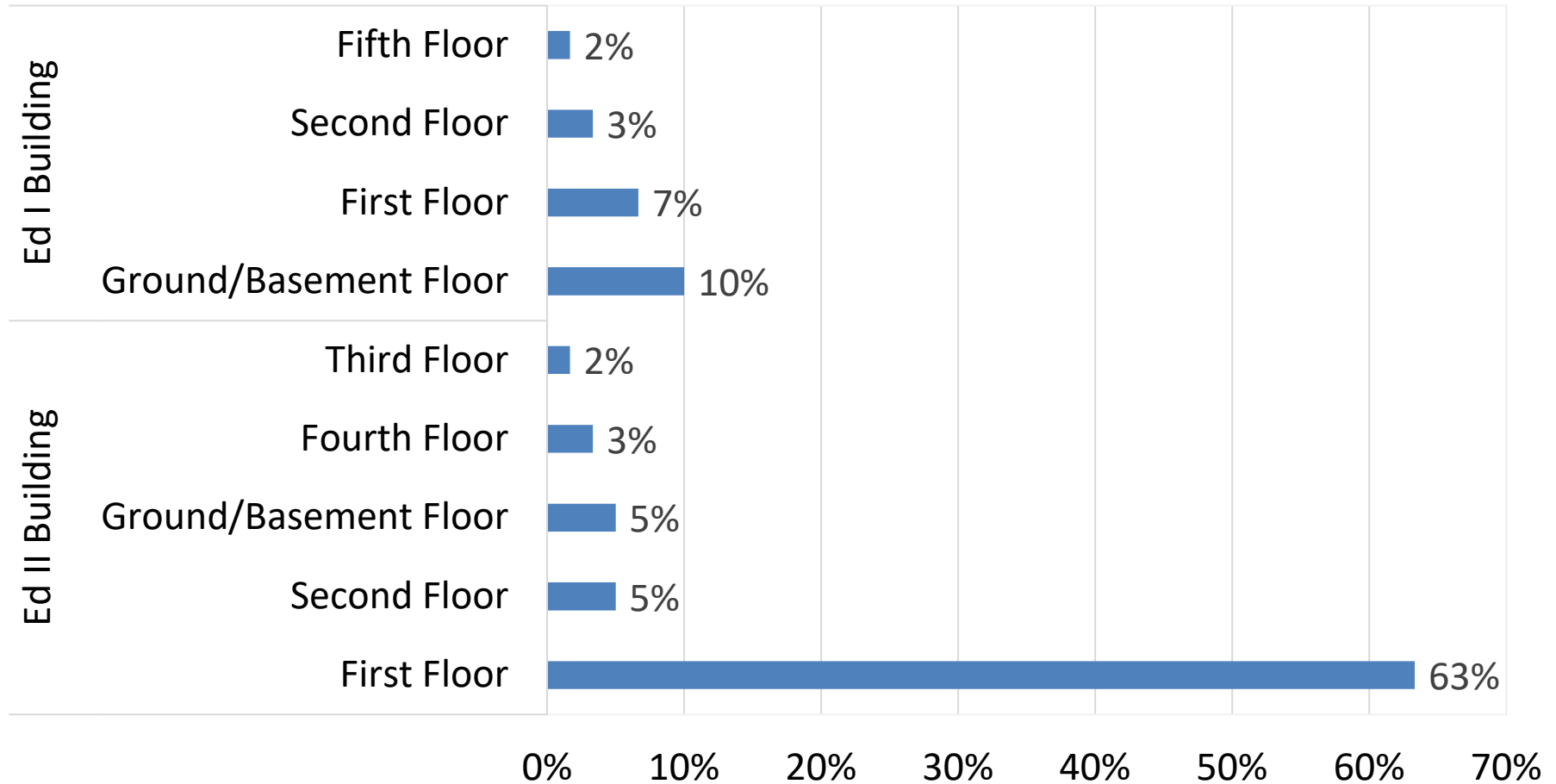
The EAA is in the Ed I and Ed II Courtyard (closest to Scotty's): [UCR Emergency Assembly Areas](#)



Please specify where the AED is on your floor.

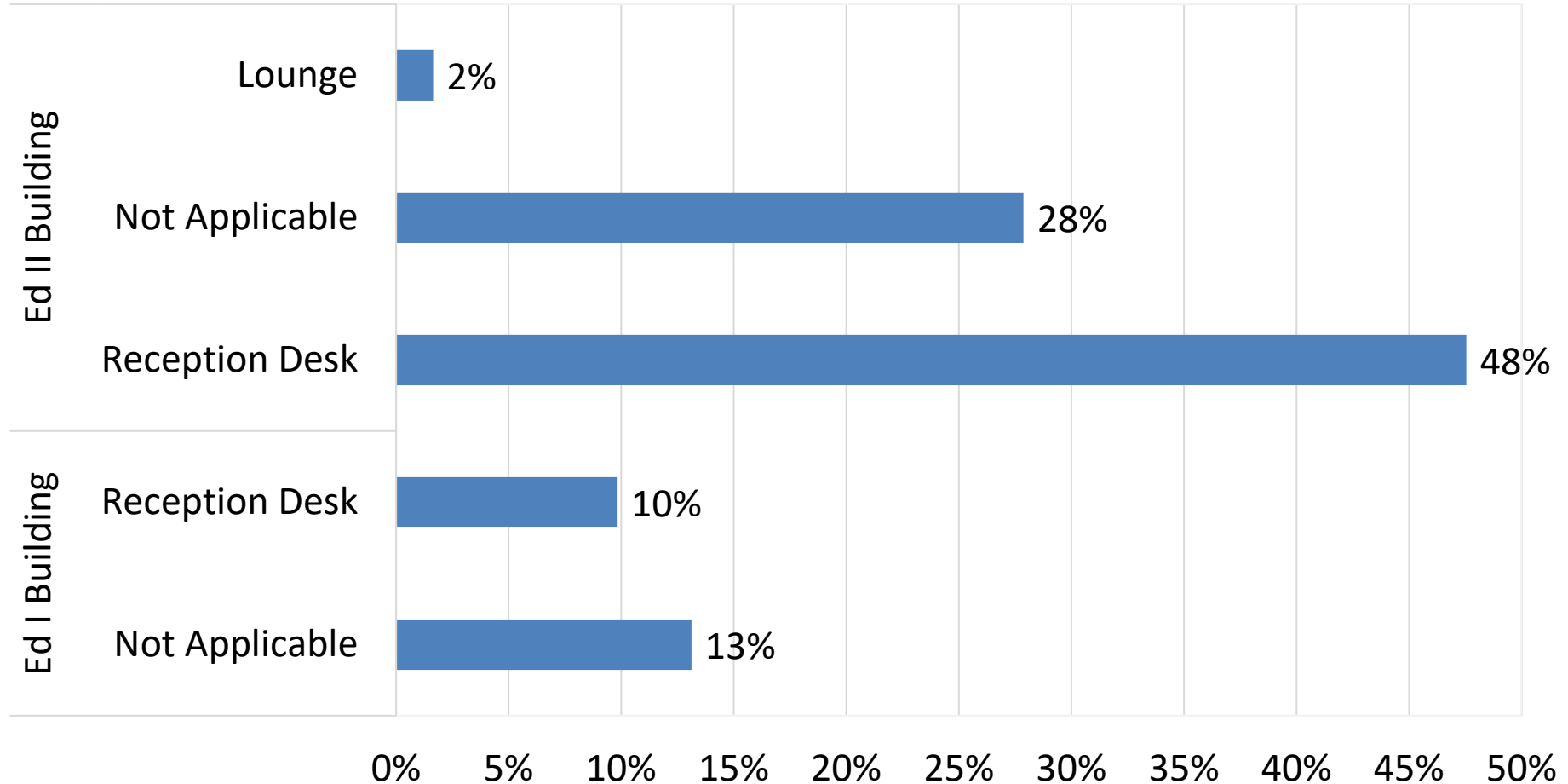
The ED I AED is located on the Ground Floor by Anatomy Lab.

The ED II AED is located on the First Floor by the Lockers: [UCR Campus AED Locations](#)



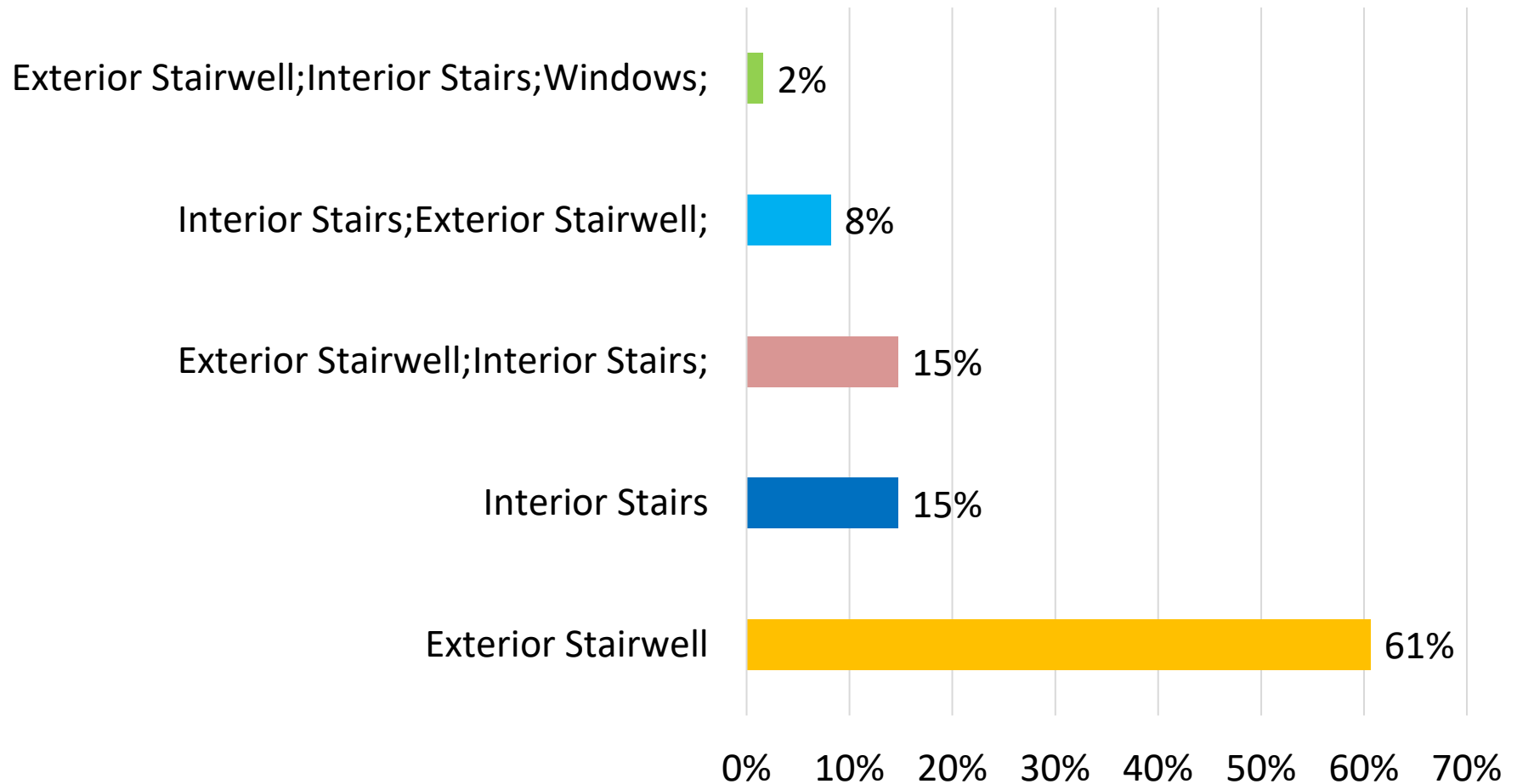
Please specify where the panic button is located.

Where are the emergency exit routes on your floor?

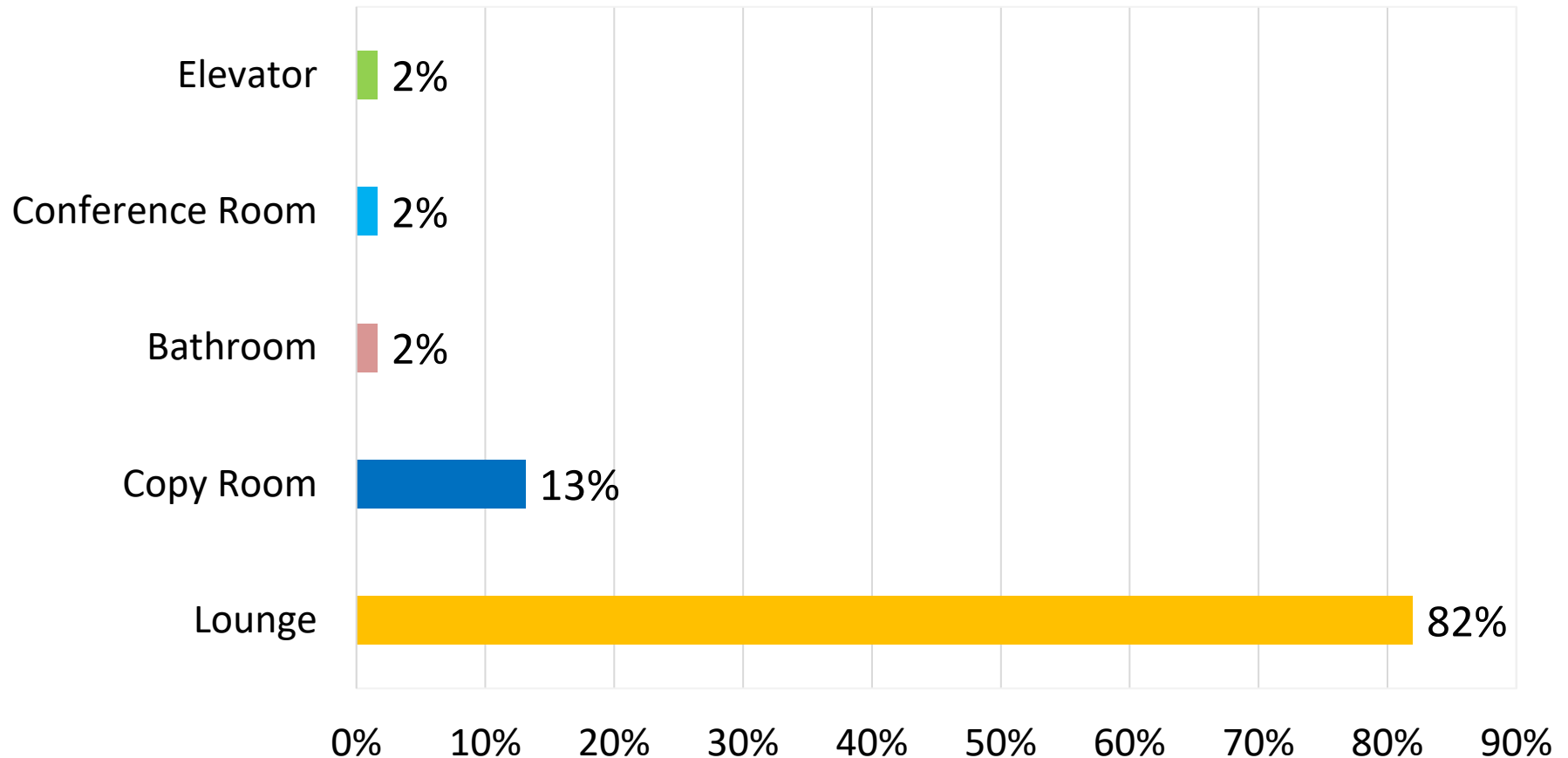
Emergency exit routes are accessible via the exterior stairwells of ED II (ED II Evac Route Maps available throughout the building) and through the interior stairwells of ED I.



Please specify where the Shelter in Place emergency bag is located.

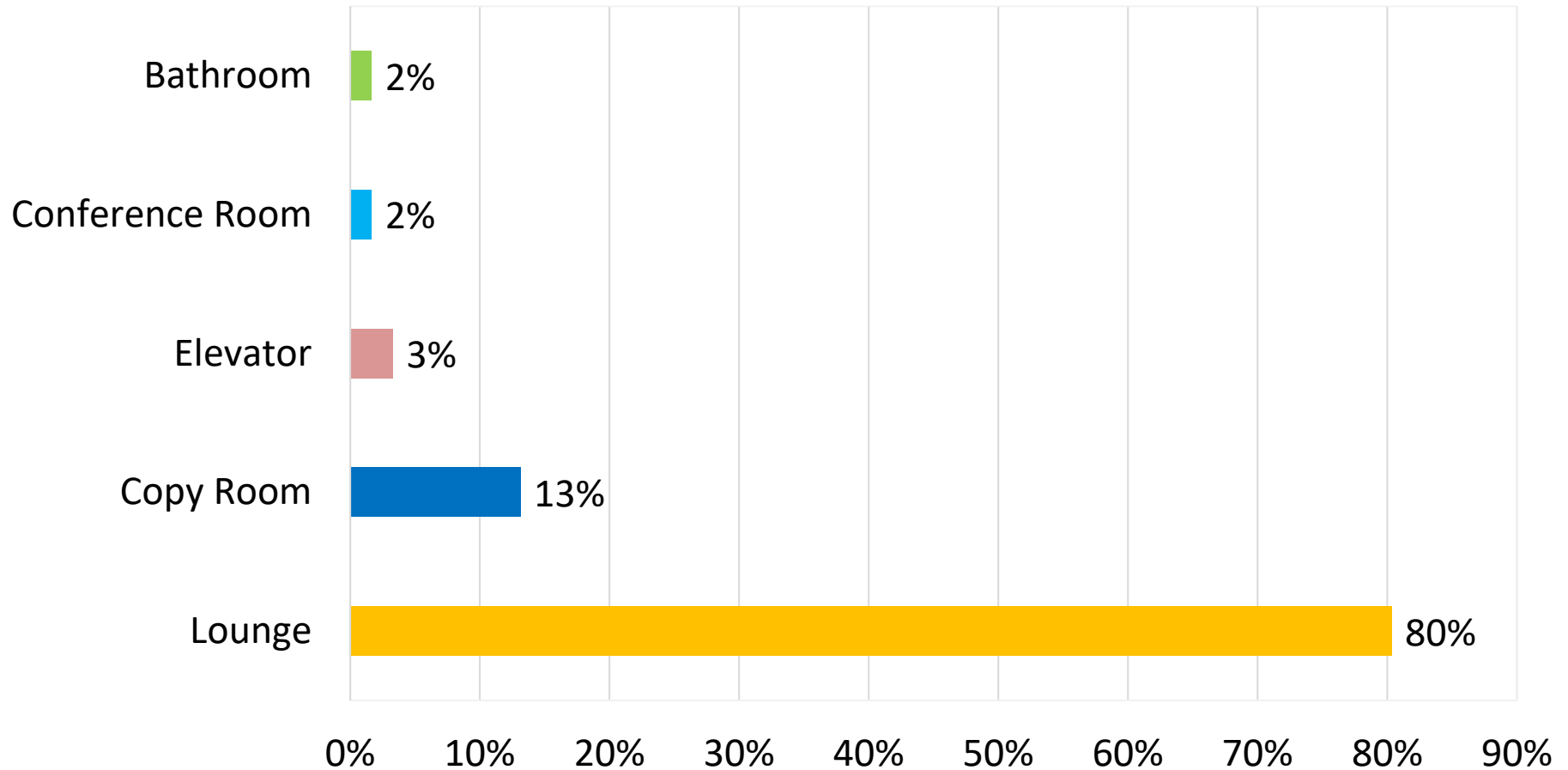
